

CMCA-Weatherization Program

I understand for weatherization services income **includes:**

- Gross wages and salaries
- Self employment, odd jobs, or babysitting
- Social Security, Supplemental Security Income, short or long term disability
- Retirement, pension, or government pension
- Workman's Compensation
- Unemployment
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- Veteran's Benefits
- Rental Property Income
- Alimony
- Income from a bank, stock dividends
- Military pay, military retirement pay, military allotments
- Training stipends, regular insurance or annuity payments
- Net receipts from non-farm self employment
- Net gambling or lottery winnings
- All other sources NOT mentioned below

All income from any of the above sources will need to be included in proof of income for the 3 months before the month of your weatherization application.

I understand for weatherization services income **does not include:**

- Child support
- Foster care payments
- Money received from the sale of a property, house, or car
- One time payment from a social service agency
- Tax Refunds
- Gifts, loans, or lump-sum inheritances
- College scholarships
- One time insurance payments or payment for an injury
- Non cash benefits such as employer paid health insurance or other fringe benefits
- Federal non cash benefits such as food stamps, medical assistance, and housing assistance
- The imputed value of rent from owner occupied non-farm or farm housing
- Depreciation from farm or business assets
- Combat zone pay to the military
- Reverse mortgages
